What the numbers say:


Progress on Racial Disparities in Flint

March: African Americans over 7 times more likely for COVID


July - October: Racial disparities eliminated!

Novemeber: Racial disparities are trending upward

Geographic Spread: October 2020



Infection Rates



*Rapid increase in testing impeded immediate ability to report data stratified by race

Recommendations

Legal Encourage safe Social Pods (group of individuals who agree to limit activities and practice social distancing with those outside of the pod)

Continue barrier-free testing (e.g., no cost, no insurance, no restrictions)

Advocate for additional resources and funding to reinforce capacity of local public health systems

Consider **community level interventions** to hinder spread (e.g., curfews, enforce punitive measurements for non-compliant businesses)
